


Timeline










Volume Evolution

Units Transported









 - Shaft generator for high reliability and operational efficiency
- 11 vessels equipped with exhaust gas cleaning systems enabling compliance with environmental regulations and shielding from oil price volatility
- 16 of the 19 owned vessels belong to 3 groups of sister ships, increasing fleet uniformity, trading flexibility and economies of scale
- ☐ 30% owned fleet capacity expansion secured with Dual Fuel eco vessels, reducing fleet age profile and emissions







Emission Reduction-A Decade Earlier than IMO Target
